ARBS has made a spectacular return to Melbourne after a six-year absence with post Covid crowds stronger than expected and the best of the HVAC&R industry in Australia on show with over 200 Exhibitors and visitor numbers in excess of 7,000.

Visitors were thirsty for knowledge and face to face connection whilst exploring the largest show of its kind in Australia with 216 feature packed stands showcasing the latest in HVAC&R and building services offerings.

The feeling on the extensive show floor was electric, allowing visitors to connect with the most influential HVAC&R and building services leaders, manufacturers, and solution providers. Visitors were also able to see fantastic product demonstrations in the Exhibitor Presentation Theatre which was a constant hive of activity. 
Visitor Professional Profile







Why do you attend ARBS?






